

## Lesson Plan

### Soil Solutions

**Book:** *Soil-Eating Animals*

**Series:** Weird Animal Diets

**Level:** Beacon

### Objective

To help students identify the reasons that certain animals eat soil.

### Supplies

- *Soil-Eating Animals* book
- Soil Solutions worksheet (attached)

### Before the Activity

Print out a copy of the Soil Solutions worksheet for each student. Read through the *Soil-Eating Animals* book, or assign it to students to read on their own.

### Activity

Pass out the Soil Solutions worksheets. Ask students to match each animal with the reason it eats soil. If students need help, they can look back at the *Soil-Eating Animals* book. Some answers are in the book's main text, but others are in fun facts or other special features.

### Evaluation

Collect the worksheets at the end of class. Use the attached answer key to give students 1 point for each correct answer, for a total of up to 6 points.

### Standards

This lesson may be used to address the Common Core State Standards' reading standards for informational text, grade 3 (RI 3.1).
