Lesson Plan

Antonym Match

Book: Near and Far Series: Opposites Level: Scout

Objective

To help students practice identifying pairs of antonyms.

Supplies

- Near and Far book
- Antonym Match Word List (attached)

Before the Activity

Print the Antonym Match Word List and cut it apart so each word is on a separate piece of paper.

Activity

Read *Near and Far* out loud to students. Explain that the words *near* and *far* are antonyms. Antonyms are words with opposite meanings. Then give each student a word from the Antonym Match Word List. Each student should try to find someone else who has the antonym of this word. If two students have words that are antonyms, they should link arms and sit down.

Evaluation

Use the attached answer key to provide prompting and support for any students who struggle to read their words or find their pairs.

Standards

This lesson may be used to address the Common Core State Standards' language standards, grade K (L K.5).
