Swift Information

Book: Taylor Swift

Series: Biggest Names in Music

Level: Navigator

Objective

To help students use indexes, tables of contents, and other text features to quickly find key information.

Supplies

- Four copies of the Taylor Swift book
- Swift Information worksheet (attached)
- Pencils

Before the Activity

Read through the *Taylor Swift* book, or assign it to students to read on their own. Print four copies of the Swift Information worksheet.

Activity

Divide students up into four groups. Give one copy of the Swift Information worksheet to each group. When you say "go," groups will race to complete the worksheet. Students in each group should search through the book to find the answers to the questions. They can use text features such as the chapter titles, the index, and the table of contents to find the information as swiftly as possible. Students should write the answer to the question and the page where they found it.

Evaluation

As soon as a group has all the answers, students should raise their hands. You'll come over and use the attached answer key to check their answers. The first group to complete the worksheet correctly wins.
