### **Pollution Words and Phrases**

**Book:** Saving Earth's Air **Series:** Saving Our Planet **Level:** Pioneer

#### Objective

To help students build vocabulary related to pollution and the environment.

#### Supplies

- Saving Earth's Air book
- Pollution Words and Phrases worksheet (attached)

#### **Before the Activity**

Print out a copy of the Pollution Words and Phrases worksheet for each student. Read the *Saving Earth's Air* book as a class, or assign it to students to read on their own.

#### Activity

Pass out the Pollution Words and Phrases worksheet. Explain that this worksheet lists vocabulary words and phrases from the book. Students should match each word to the correct definition. Students can use the book's text and glossary for help.

#### **Evaluation**

Using the attached answer key, give students 1 point for each correct match, for up to 8 points total.
