

Lesson Plan

Either Or

Series: Sports (Set 2)

Level: Scout

Objective

To help students practice reading a short book about a sport and answering simple questions about what they read.

Supplies

- Several books in the Sports series

Before the Activity

Set out the Sports books so that students can choose one to read.

Activity

Split students into pairs. Have each pair pick a book from the Sports series to read together. Students should take turns reading one page of their books aloud to their partners. Once all students have finished reading, ask the following questions. Read each question aloud. Then, have students share their answers by raising their hands:

- Is your sport played indoors or outdoors? Raise your hand if your sport is played indoors. Now raise your hand if it's played outdoors.
- Do people play on teams or on their own? Raise your hand if your sport uses teams. Now raise your hand if people do your sport on their own.
- Does this sport use a ball? Raise your hand if your sport uses a ball. Now raise your hand if it does not.
- Would you want to play this sport? Raise your hand if your answer is yes. Now raise your hand if the answer is no.

Evaluation

Could students read their books to their partners? Could they answer the questions about their sport?

Standards

This lesson may be used to address the Common Core State Standards' reading standards for informational text, grade 1 (RI 1.1, 1.2).
